

Support Documentation of ISCIE Submission Rules

This document is a translation of the ISCIE submission rules originally written in Japanese. The rules officially follow the Japanese version.

1. This document includes submission rules of the Journal of the Institute of Systems, Control and Information Engineers (Systems, Control and Information) hereinafter called "journal" and the Transactions of the Institute of Systems, Control and Information Engineers hereinafter called "transactions".
2. At least one of the authors must be an ISCIE member or an ISCIE student member when the manuscript is submitted. Invited papers and others permitted by the editorial committee of ISCIE are an exception.
3. The manuscripts must be unpublished except ones permitted by the editorial committee of ISCIE.
4. The manuscript submitted is reviewed. Based on the comments and judgments of the referees, the editorial committee of ISCIE decides acceptance or rejection. The author may be requested to revise the paper.
5. Copyrights of all papers and articles, appearing in the journal and transactions shall be transferred to ISCIE. However, the authors retain the right to copy, translate or modify their own manuscripts. In cases when a manuscript is translated into another language or when modified one is to be submitted to another publication, the original article should be clearly cited in the publications. On behalf of the authors, ISCIE may grant a permission to copy or reprint to a third party which ISCIE deems to be appropriate. In such case, ISCIE may receive a payment, if any, from a third party.
6. Manuscripts should be written in Japanese or English. The author should prepare the manuscript according to the author's guidelines.
7. There are two types of submission for the transactions: Paper and Short Paper.

Papers published in the transactions include reports on new research and developments performed by the ISCIE members such as detailed below and the contents of which may advance the development of science and industry:

(a) Reports on new theories, revelations, technologies, methods

(b) Reports on extensions, supplements, systematizations and applications of conventional results

Short Papers published in the transactions include reports on research for prompt announcement and suggestions of new visions, techniques and methods.

The standard number of pages is 8 for Paper and 2 for Short Paper. Short Paper should not exceed 3 pages.

8. It shall be the responsibility of the author to ensure the reliability of the article published in the transactions.
9. For submission, all documents instructed in the author's guidelines for the transactions should be sent to the editorial committee of ISCIE. The date the editorial committee of ISCIE receives the submission will be the official reception date of the Paper or Short Paper. If the manuscript is requested to be revised and the revised manuscript is not resubmitted by the due date, then the manuscript will be considered as a new submission. All authors are required to purchase at least 50 reprints of their article.
10. Revisions or repeal of the rules shall be done by the administrative board of ISCIE.
