Manuscript Format

The manuscript should be written in English and prepared according to the author's guidelines for the transactions of ISCIE. The standard number of pages is eight. The author's guidelines, submission rules,

Submission

The original manuscript should be submitted according to the instructions of the ISCIE online submission system. Please note that at least one of the authors must be an ISCIE member or a student member. All submissions will be peer reviewed. The author of the accepted paper will have to pay the page charge according to the author's guidelines.

July 31, 2020

Process for publication etc.

All submissions will be peer reviewed. Those accepted will be published in Vol.34, No.1. **But it may not be published in Vol.34, No.1 or No.2 even if accepted.** After the acceptance, the authors will be requested to submit their electronic source files (LaTeX, Word etc.), figures and photos of the authors.
